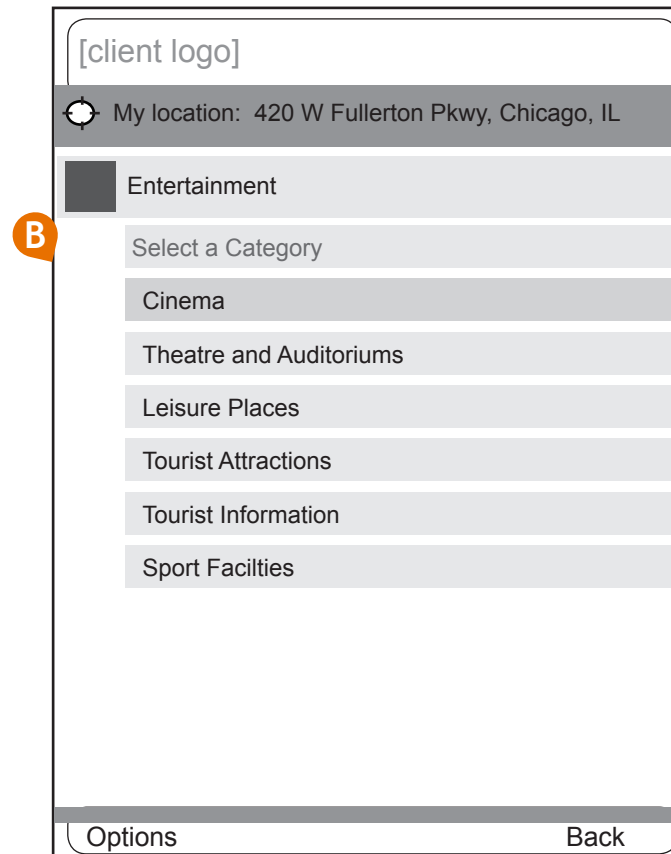
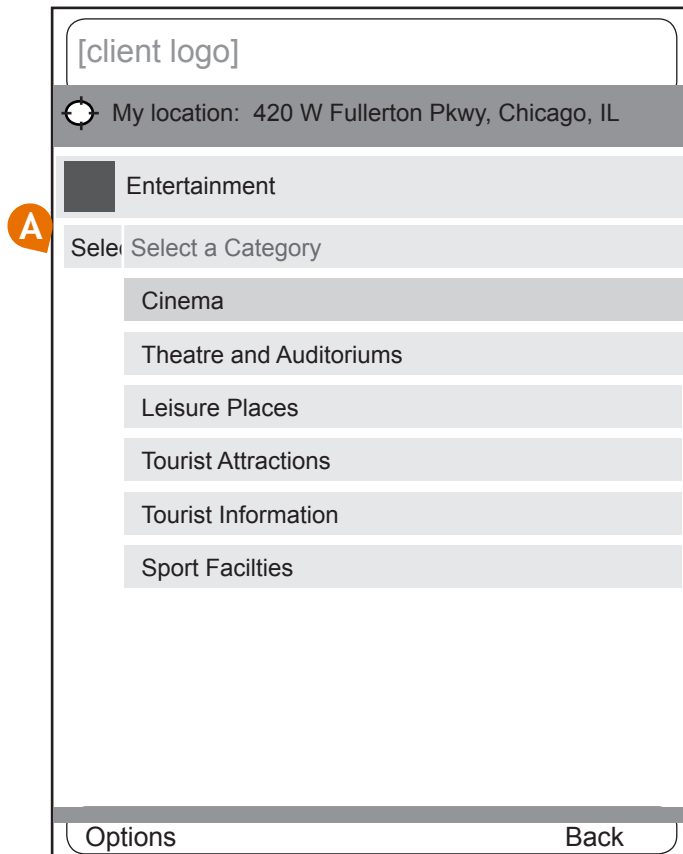

Selecting sub-category

Remove overlapping text under drop-down list so that screen appears as in **Figure B**.



Selecting attributes

After a user has selected a category (e.g. 'Accommodations') and sub-category ('e.g. 'Hotels'), this view prompts the user to specify one or more attributes (e.g. 'Price').

5.1 Sub-category has one attribute

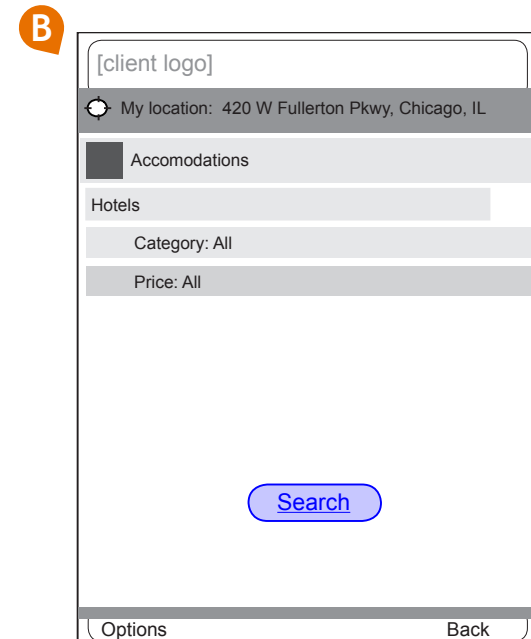
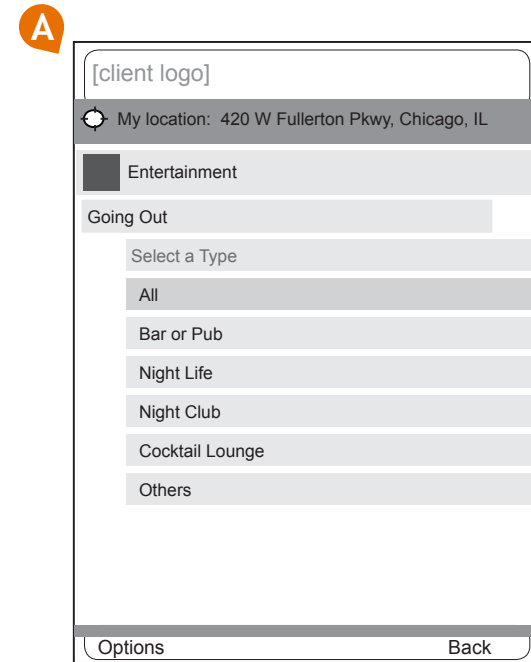

If a sub-category has only one possible attribute (e.g. 'Type'), the drop-down list should appear automatically with 'All' as the first item in the list. Do not show a "Search" button. Instead, when the user presses "fire" on an item, go directly to the list of results (section 6).

5.2 Sub-category has more than one attribute

Figure B.

If a sub-category has more than one attribute (e.g. 'Type' and 'Price') present the menu with 'Search' button as is currently implemented.

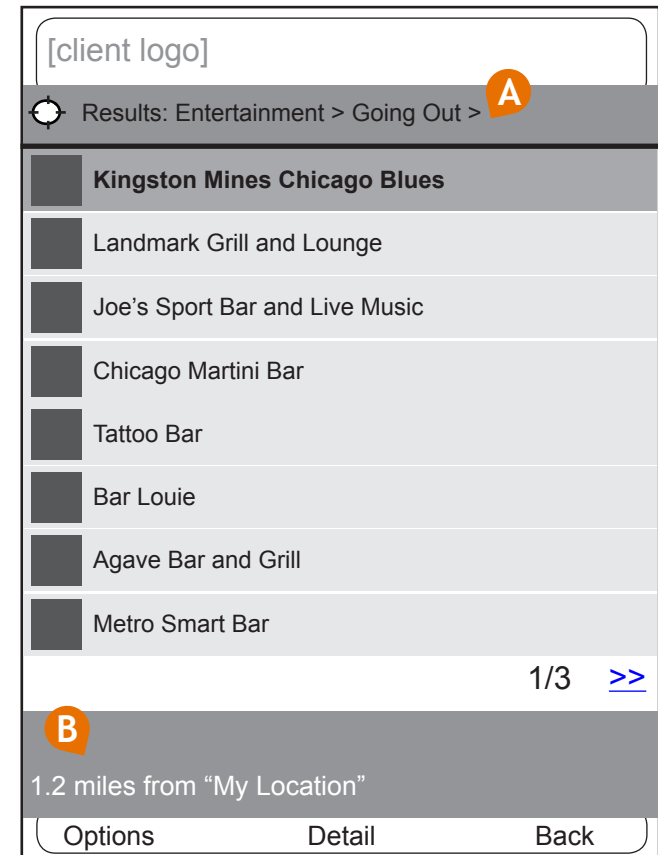

At the top, display “Results: <Category Type> > <Category>” or “Results: <user’s search query>”.

Figure B.

If coming from “Browse Categories”, hide the category display at the bottom and leave the space blank.

When coming from "Directions" or "Change Location" flow, disable options and show a "Select" button instead.

When user presses "Select" user should be directly returned to the starting point of the flow. **No confirmation is necessary.**

If the user came from "Change Location", the new location should be set and the user taken back to home page (**section 1**).

If the user came from "Directions", they should be taken back to the "Directions" page (**section 10**) with the respective field populated.
